Chris is arranging to meet with the new head of Planning at CCBC for a discussion on issues in the area.

12. Clerks Report – Council agreed the Audit and Chris signed paperwork.

Sally informed Councillors that the Urdd fundraising Picnic had made a profit of £275.

A Letter has been received from the Post Office regarding our request to re-site the post, they feel it is unnecessary and would be costly. This is to be taken to the Draethen Community Group for discussion.

The Waterloo Project is hopefully moving again now. The digger has been and levelled out the land ready for the next phase. Sally is currently applying for a grant from CCBC – this would enable us to do the job properly and install a shelter and notice board as part of the project.

13. We have been asked to consider an increase to the annual grasscutting grant for the churchyard. Agreed to ask the cost to the Parish and then agree an increase.

14. Reports from Councillors:

Draethen – Margaret gave Council information on a scheme '20 is plenty' – Sally to look into the feasibility of introducing this scheme in the area.

Waterloo – The Waterloo Village Green Project starting to take shape. A volunteer day to be arranged in next couple of weeks.
